As our Clinician, you will develop therapeutic care plans for children and youth who have experienced developmental trauma including abuse, neglect, disrupted attachments, loss, family adversity, and pre-natal exposure to alcohol and drugs that affect their emotional, social, cognitive and behavioral development. In regular intervals you will review the reports, touching base with managers to ensure care plans are suited to clients' needs, monitoring their effectiveness, and modifying as necessary.

In addition, the clinician provides support to front-line staff through coaching, mentorship, training, clinical supervision, and advice to encourage effective implementation of care plans. - Collaborative and open to feedback, with a strong commitment to continuously improve personal practice in order to better support the team;
- Comfortable working independently, exercising sound judgment with minimal supervision;
- Adaptable, patient, and composed under pressure in a dynamic environment with evolving staff and client needs.

- Current registration with the professional body, current liability insurance and professional references
- Police Information Check (with vulnerable sector) and Child Intervention Record Check (both within the last 6 months)
